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## **Product Update**

palonosetron, 250 micrograms solution for injection (Aloxi<sup>®</sup>) SMC No. (1073/15) Chugai Pharma UK Limited

10 July 2015

The Scottish Medicines Consortium (SMC) has completed its assessment of the above product and advises NHS Boards and Area Drug Therapeutic Committees (ADTCs) on its use in NHS Scotland. The advice is summarised as follows:

ADVICE: following an abbreviated submission

palonosetron (Aloxi®) is accepted for use within NHS Scotland.

**Indication under review:** prevention of acute nausea and vomiting associated with highly emetogenic cancer chemotherapy and prevention of nausea and vomiting associated with moderately emetogenic cancer chemotherapy, in paediatric patients 1 month of age and older.

A phase III double blind study demonstrated non-inferiority of palonosetron to another 5-HT<sub>3</sub> antagonist in paediatric patients.
