The Scottish Medicines Consortium (SMC) has completed its assessment of the above product and advises NHS Boards and ADTCs on its use in NHS Scotland. The advice is summarised as follows:

ADVICE: following an abbreviated submission

Imigran Radis® film-coated tablets are accepted for use within NHS Scotland for acute relief of migraine attacks, with or without aura, provided there is a clear diagnosis of migraine. They offer a fast disintegrating oral formulation of sumatripan succinate. No increased cost is associated with this product compared to prescribing conventional Imigran® tablets.
