Product Update

The Scottish Medicines Consortium has completed its assessment of the above product and advises Area Drug and Therapeutic Committees (ADTCs) on its use in NHS Scotland. The advice is summarised as follows:

ADVICE: following an abbreviated submission

Travoprost/timolol (Duotrav^o) **eye drops** are accepted for use in NHS Scotland for whom this is an appropriate combination of agents. They decrease intra-ocular pressure in patients with open-angle glaucoma or ocular hypertension who are insufficiently responsive to topical beta-blockers or prostaglandin analogues alone.

There is no significant additional cost associated with the combination product compared with the individual components and it allows patients to administer fewer drops.
