Statement of Advice:

abatacept 125mg solution for injection (pre-filled syringe); 125mg solution for injection in pre-filled pen; 250mg powder for concentrate for solution for infusion (Orencia®) SMC No 1287/17

Bristol-Myers Squibb Pharmaceuticals Limited

ADVICE: in the absence of a submission from the holder of the marketing authorisation

abatacept (Orencia®) is not recommended for use within NHS Scotland.

Indication under review: Alone or in combination with methotrexate for the treatment of active psoriatic arthritis in adult patients when the response to previous disease-modifying anti-rheumatic drug (DMARD) therapy including methotrexate has been inadequate, and for whom additional systemic therapy for psoriatic skin lesions is not required.

The holder of the marketing authorisation has not made a submission to SMC regarding this product in this setting. As a result we cannot recommend its use within NHSScotland.
