progesterone 25mg solution for injection (Lubion®)

The Scottish Medicines Consortium (SMC) has completed its assessment of the above product and advises NHS Boards and Area Drug and Therapeutic Committees (ADTCs) on its use in NHS Scotland. The advice is summarised as follows:

ADVICE: following an abbreviated submission

progesterone (Lubion®) is accepted for use within NHS Scotland.

Indication under review: in adults for luteal support as part of an Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART) treatment program in infertile women who are unable to use or tolerate vaginal preparations.

This increases the range of progesterone preparations available for use in NHS Scotland. Lubion[®] is an aqueous formulation and may be administered subcutaneously or intramuscularly.
